**MANDATORY & ENFORCEABLE CODES OF
CONDUCT**

The St Kilda City Junior Football Club (STKCJFC) fully supports the codes of conduct as introduced by the AFL and AFL Victoria.

PARENTS & SUPPORTERS CODE OF CONDUCT

- Remember that you are there for the participants to enjoy the game;
- Encourage participation, but don't force it;
- Teach that enjoyment is more important than winning;
- Never ridicule mistakes or losses – supporters are there to support not downgrade;
- Lead by example and respect all players, coaches, umpires and spectators – physical or verbal abuse will not be tolerated;
- Recognise all volunteers who are giving up their valuable time;
- Never publicly criticise umpires – raise personal concerns with club officials in private; and
- Don't use ugly remarks based on race, religion, gender or ability – you'll let down your family and yourself if you do – & many such comments are actually now illegal.

By registering your child to play with the Club, or attend a game during the season, you acknowledge that as a parent, guardian or spectator you have read, understood and agree to abide by the Code. Note, SMJFL and Club sanctions exist and will be enforced where there is a breach of this Code.
