**MANDATORY & ENFORCEABLE CODES OF
CONDUCT**

The St Kilda City Junior Football Club (STKCJFC) fully supports the codes of conduct as introduced by the AFL and AFL Victoria.

PLAYER'S CODE OF CONDUCT

- Play by the rules – the rules of your club and the laws of the game;
- Never argue with an umpire or other official – without these people, you can't play football;
- Control your temper - verbal abuse of officials and sledging other players doesn't help you enjoy or win any games;
- Be a team player – It's a team game, treat it that way;
- Treat all players as you would like to be treated – fairly;
- Co-operate with your coach, the umpires and team-mates;
- Play for your own enjoyment & to improve your skills; AND
- Don't use ugly remarks based on race, religion, gender or ability – you'll let down your coach, teammates and family if you do – & many such comments are actually now illegal.

By registering with the Club, you acknowledge that as an individual player, a parent or guardian and as a family, you understand and agree to abide by the Code. Note, SMJFL and Club sanctions exist and will be enforced where there is a breach of this Code.
